ALBERTA REGULATION 122/2004 INSURANCE ACT  
DIAGNOSTIC and TREATMENT PROTOCOL REGULATION

If you are injured in a motor vehicle accident you should visit your health care practitioner- either a physician, chiropractor or physiotherapist.

Based on their assessment of your injury you will be able to access either 10 or 21 medical, physical therapy, chiropractic **and ADJUNCT THERAPY- MASSAGE THERAPY or ACUPUNCTURE visits.**

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS ABOUT YOUR TREATMENT OPTIONS and you also have the right to change your primary health care provider if you feel that your needs are not being met.

If your Primary Health Care Practitioner diagnoses you with:

-a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> degree strain, 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> degree sprain, or whiplash associated disorder diagnosed as a WAD I:

They will authorize a combined total of **10 medical, physical therapy, chiropractic and massage and acupuncture visits**

-a 3<sup>rd</sup> degree strain, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree sprain, or whiplash associated disorder diagnosed as WAD II:

They will authorize a combined total of **21 medical, physical therapy, chiropractic and massage and acupuncture visits**

“nothing in this Regulation prevents or limits a client or Health Care Practitioner from applying to an insurer for a service or supply in addition to the limits specified by the Regulation...”
